

No. 204. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1936.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1936, do hereby declare the acquisition of the accommodation road constructed in connection with the Government waterworks at Sykhari branching off from the Dhikomo-Sykhari Road and leading to the adits and the head well of the said waterworks to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Water Engineer the effectuation of the said undertaking.

The Quarantine Law, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and it is hereby declared that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 177, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th July, 1941, is hereby cancelled.
