THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS LAWS, 1934 AND 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2023

MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Game and Wild Birds Laws, 1934 and 1938, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game Reserve Areas (Amendment) Order, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Game Reserve Areas Order, 1938, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Game Reserve Areas Orders, 1938 and 1941.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following area as Area No. 6:—

"Area No. 6 (*Larnaca District*):

Commencing at a point on the boundary between the Nicosia and Larnaca Districts, such point being on the road from Pyroi to Athienou and distant about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the main road Nicosia-Larnaca, the boundary of the area follows the Nicosia-Larnaca District boundary northerly and easterly a distance of about $8\frac{1}{2}$ miles until it reaches the road from Aphanía to Melousha; thence southerly following the said road for a distance of about 1 mile to the village of Melousha; thence south-westerly following the road from Melousha to Athienou to the village of Athienou; thence westerly following the road from Athienou to Pyroi, a distance of about $2\frac{3}{4}$ miles to the point of commencement."

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1941.

GENERAL LICENCE MADE UNDER SECTION 3 AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF FEES IN RESPECT OF PATENTS, DESIGNS AND TRADE MARKS.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 3 of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1941, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby authorize—

- (a) the payment on behalf of any person not being an enemy of any fees necessary for obtaining the grant of or for obtaining the renewal of patents, or for obtaining the registration of designs or trade marks or the renewal of such registration, in enemy territory, and the payment to enemies of their charges and expenses in relation to the matters aforesaid;

(b) the payment on behalf of an enemy of any fees payable on application for or renewal of the grant of patents, or on application for the registration of designs or trade marks or the renewal of such registration in any country not being enemy or neutral territory and the payment on behalf of an enemy to persons not being enemies of their charges and expenses, in relation to the matters aforesaid, and the receipt of payments from an enemy in relation to the matters aforesaid :

Provided always that any payment on behalf of an enemy under this paragraph, unless it is made by a person who has an interest in or under the patent, design or trade mark in question, may be made by the person making the same only out of moneys—

- (i) remitted by or on behalf of such enemy, or
- (ii) accrued due to such enemy since the outbreak of war, or
- (iii) owed by a patent agent (in his business as such) in the United Kingdom to a patent agent in enemy territory,

and not by way of gift or by way of advancement or loan to or on account of such enemy.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940.

NOTICE No. 42 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 14 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“ PART 14.—FASOULIA BEANS.

(1)	(2)	(3)
Type.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
Rose coco beans	10 piastres per oke.	9 piastres per oke.
All other types	12 piastres per oke.	11 piastres per oke.

In this part of the Schedule—

the term ‘ wholesale ’ means sale or purchase of fasoulia beans in quantities in excess of 40 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Limitation : No person who has in his possession or under his control more than 40 okes of fasoulia beans shall refuse to sell by wholesale.”

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 18 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“ PART 18.—MATCHES.

Brand of Matches.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
1. ‘ Scissors ’ brand (red-sticks) in boxes of 60 matches.	8 piastres per packet of 10 boxes or 70 paras per two boxes.	77 piastres per 100 boxes.
2. ‘ Tekka ’ brand ..	8 piastres per packet of 10 boxes or 70 paras per two boxes.	74 piastres per 100 boxes.
3. All brands not otherwise specified.	6½ piastres per packet of 10 boxes or 30 paras per box.	7 shillings per 100 boxes.

In this part of the Schedule—

the term ‘ wholesale ’ means sale or purchase of matches of not less than 100 boxes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Limitation : No person selling matches by retail shall refuse to sell a packet of 10 boxes.”
