## THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

## REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

## J. V. W. SHAW,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:-

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Elementary Education Laws, Short title. 1933 to 1937, (Amendment) Regulations, 1941, and shall be construed as one with the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1937, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law ").

- 2. Section 72 of the principal Law shall be amended and shall stand amended Amendment during the continuance in force of these regulations, as follows :-
  - (a) by the deletion in sub-section (1) of the words "first day of September" and the substitution therefor of the words "fifteenth day of October";
  - (b) by the insertion in sub-section (4) immediately after the words "a copy of the list" (line 1) of the following words :-"shall be published by the Chairman of the Town Committee concerned

in one issue of a Greek newspaper circulating in the Colony and also "; (c) by the addition thereto of the following sub-sections as sub-sections (12) and (13) :=

"(12) Notwithstanding anything in this Law contained the Director of Education may at his discretion expend from money assessed by a Town Committee or Village Commission and recovered under the provisions of this section, such sums as he may consider fair and reasonable for the needs of children who would normally attend the school of the town or village in respect of the school of which the assessment was made, but who are temporarily attending another school.

(13) For the purposes of this section—

'Orthodox Christian inhabitants of the town or village' means the Orthodox-Christian persons who were ordinarily inhabitants of the town or village concerned on the 1st day of January, 1941."

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st Date of day of September, 1941.
