SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 234. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 3) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 33.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 33 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Closing Time of Places of Public Resort and Entertainments) (Nicosia-Kyrenia) Order, 1941, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. This Order shall apply and shall be in operation in all towns and villages in the Districts of Nicosia and Kyrenia.

3. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 4 hereof:—

(a) all coffee-shops, clubs, restaurants, theatres, cinematograph theatres, confectioners' shops, cabarets and any other place or premises of public resort whatsoever on which intoxicating liquors are not sold by retail shall be closed and remain closed except during the hours between 5 a.m. and 12 midnight.

(b) all coffee-shops, clubs, restaurants, theatres, cinematograph theatres, confectioners' shops, cabarets and any other place or premises of public resort whatsoever on which intoxicating liquors are sold by retail:

(i) if situated within the municipal limits of the town of Nicosia or Kyrenia or within the limits of any village declared to be a summer resort under the provisions of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, shall be closed and remain closed except during the hours between 5 a.m. and 11 p.m.;

(ii) if situated elsewhere than in the places in sub-paragraph (i) hereof mentioned, shall be closed and remain closed except during the hours between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m.

4. Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 3 hereof contained, any of the places or premises therein mentioned may, upon the manager or person in charge thereof obtaining a permit under my hand, remain open until such time as may be specified in such permit and such permit may contain such conditions as I may seem fit to impose.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of this Order; or

(b) fails to observe or comply with any of the conditions imposed in a permit issued under the provisions of paragraph 4 of this Order,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941.

6. The Defence (Closing Time of Places of Public Resort and Entertainments) (Nicosia-Kyrenia) Order, 1939, is hereby revoked.
