No. 247. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations :-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Amendment No. 4) Regulations. 1941, and shall be read as one with the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941, Gazettes: thereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Supplement Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Defence No. 3:

2. Regulation 94 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraph as paragraph (2), the first part thereof

being numbered as paragraph (1):

"(2) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (1) hereof contained but without prejudice to the operation thereof, any person who commits an offence against regulations 13, 32, 33, 39A, 40, 41, 43, 55, 61, 69, 71, 75, 85 and 90 or any one of them may be tried by a Magistrate and on conviction shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine:

Provided that where the prosecution is being conducted by a Law Officer or a Police Officer the Magistrate shall not deal with the case without the

consent of such officer."

(2) The Interpretation Law, 1935, shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law.
