SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 256. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (2):—

"(2A) Where any person who has been an enemy for the purposes of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1941, ceases to be an enemy for the purposes aforesaid, then, until it is otherwise directed by or on behalf of the Governor, any sums from time to time standing to the credit of an account of that person at any office or branch in the Colony of any banker, being an account in existence at the time when he ceased to be an enemy for the said purposes, shall not be dealt with except with permission granted by or on behalf of the Governor."

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th day of August, 1941.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.
