Whereas His Excellency the Governor has, under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, by Order published under Notification No. 167 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* dated the 9th July, 1941, ordered the Committee of Management for Maronite Schools to repair the girls' school in the village of Kormakiti, in the District of Kyrenia :

And whereas the necessary estimates and plans have been prepared under section 53 of the above-mentioned Laws :

And whereas a loan amounting to the sum mentioned in the third column of the Schedule hereto, has, under section 51 (1) of the said Laws, been raised to meet the expense of providing such buildings as aforesaid :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that in order to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loan aforesaid the sum of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule be recovered from the Maronite taxpayers of the village mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule in manner provided by section 74 of the said Laws.

And whereas loans amounting to the sums mentioned in the third column of the Schedule hereto have, under section 51 (1) and (2), been raised to meet the expense of providing such buildings as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that in order to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loans aforesaid the sums of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule hereto be recovered respectively from the church or churches, monastery or throne and the Orthodox-Christian inhabitants of the towns and villages mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule in manner provided by section 72 of the above Laws.

THE TRADE UNIONS AND TRADE DISPUTES LAW, 1941.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

*Acting Governor.*

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 59 of the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Law, 1941, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Regulations, 1941. Short title.
2. In these regulations—  
“the Law” means the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Law, 1941. Definition.
3. The register of trade unions which the Registrar is required to keep under section 7 of the Law, shall be in the Form No. 1 in the First Schedule hereto, and shall contain the particulars therein set out. Register of Trade Unions.
4. Every application for the registration of a trade union shall be in the Form No. 2 in the First Schedule hereto and shall contain the particulars therein set out. Application for registration.
5. The general statement of the assets and liabilities to be delivered to the Registrar by a trade union established before the commencement of the Law shall be in the Form No. 3 in the First Schedule hereto and shall contain the particulars therein set out. Statement of assets and liabilities.
6. The certificate of registration of a trade union shall be in the Form No. 4 in the First Schedule hereto. Certificate of registration.
7. The fees set out in the Second Schedule hereto shall be charged and paid by means of uncanceled stamps. Fees.
8. Any document required to be kept by the Registrar under the provisions of the Law may be inspected by any person during office hours on payment of 1s. for every hour or part thereof during which the inspection is made. Inspection of documents.
9. Trade union funds may be invested in any Government stock or stock of any municipality in the British Empire or in any Bank or Savings Bank approved by the Registrar. Investment of union funds.
10. There shall be kept by every trade union the following books and registers:—  
(a) a cash-book in which there shall be entered regularly all receipts and payments;  
(b) counterfoil receipt books for the issue of receipts for all moneys received by or on behalf of the trade union with corresponding details shown on the foil;  
(c) register of members showing the name, trade or calling and address of each member, the date of his admission and the subscriptions paid. Books and registers.
11. The secretary of every trade union shall, within seven days from the date of a request by the Registrar in that behalf, submit to the Registrar an up-to-date list of all members of the trade union. List of members.
