THE TRADE UNIONS AND TRADE DISPUTES LAW, 1941.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

J. V. W. SHAW. Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 59 of the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Law, 1941, do hereby make the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Short title. Regulations, 1941.

2. In these regulations-"the Law" means the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Law, 1941.

Definition.

3. The register of trade unions which the Registrar is required to keep under Register section 7 of the Law, shall be in the Form No. 1 in the First Schedule hereto, and of Trade shall contain the particulars therein set out.

4. Every application for the registration of a trade union shall be in the Form Application No. 2 in the First Schedule hereto and shall contain the particulars therein set out.

5. The general statement of the assets and liabilities to be delivered to the Statement Registrar by a trade union established before the commencement of the Law shall of assets and be in the Form No. 3 in the First Schedule hereto and shall contain the particulars liabilities.

6. The certificate of registration of a trade union shall be in the Form No. 4 Certificate in the First Schedule hereto.

7. The fees set out in the Second Schedule hereto shall be charged and paid by Fees. means of uncancelled stamps.

8. Any document required to be kept by the Registrar under the provisions of Inspection of the Law may be inspected by any person during office hours on payment of 1s. for documents. every hour or part thereof during which the inspection is made.

9. Trade union funds may be invested in any Government stock or stock of Investment any municipality in the British Empire or in any Bank or Savings Bank approved of union by the Registrar.

10. There shall be kept by every trade union the following books and registers:— Books and (a) a cash-book in which there shall be entered regularly all receipts and registers. payments;

(b) counterfoil receipt books for the issue of receipts for all moneys received by or on behalf of the trade union with corresponding details shown on the foil;

(c) register of members showing the name, trade or calling and address of each member, the date of his admission and the subscriptions paid.

11. The secretary of every trade union shall, within seven days from the date List of of a request by the Registrar in that behalf, submit to the Registrar an up-to-date members. list of all members of the trade union.
