THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

With reference to Notification No. 277 published in *Gazette* No. 2036 of the 7th March, 1930, it is ordered that from and after the 21st November, 1941, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the burial-ground referred to in the said Notification has been provided. THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940.

NOTICE No. 49 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the *Exception* to Part 2 and the substitution therefor of the following:—

“*Exception*: Where barley is issued either for cash or on deferred payment by the Director of Agriculture the prices may be as fixed by the Director of Agriculture.”

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 12 and the substitution therefor of the following part:—

“PART 12.—LENTILS.

Price when Ground.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
10 piastres per oke.	9 piastres per oke.	8 piastres per oke.

In this Part of the Schedule—

the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of lentils in quantities in excess of 40 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Limitation: No person who has in his possession or under his control more than 40 okes of lentils shall refuse to sell by wholesale.”

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 33 and the substitution therefor of the following part:—

“PART 33.—COTTON SEED OIL.

Type of Cotton Seed Oil.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
1. Cotton seed oil refined ‘Luxor Brand’ in new sealed tins of 7 okes each net.	13 shillings per tin.	12 shillings per tin.
2. Cotton seed oil refined ‘Luxor Brand’ in new sealed tins of 2 okes each net.	4 shillings 2 piastres per tin.	3 shillings 8 piastres per tin.
3. All other types	37 piastres per litre.	34 piastres per litre.

In this Part of the Schedule—

the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of cotton seed oil in quantities in excess of 4 tins of 7 okes or 12 tins of 2 okes in respect of ‘Luxor Brand’ and of 5 litres in respect of all other types at any one time or at any single transaction.”
