No. 279. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1936.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

J. V. W. SHAW,

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to maintain the existing Nursery Garden at Polis in the District of Paphos:

Now, therefore, I, John Valentine Wistar Shaw, Acting Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1936, do hereby declare the acquisition of the land required for the aforesaid purpose to be an undertaking of public utility, and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Director of Agriculture the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.

NOTICE NO. 1 UNDER CLAUSE 8.

The Schedule to the above Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words:—

" Edible Oils of all kinds.

The normal quantity shall be one month's requirements for the household calculated on a basis of 100 drams per person per month".

and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"Edible Fats of all kinds.

The normal quantity shall be 2 okes per household".
