THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY ACQUISITION (ALIENS) LAWS, 1936.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2009

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens) Laws, 1936, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens Restriction) Order, 1941.

2. From and after the date of this Order, no alien shall acquire, otherwise than by inheritance, ownership of any immovable property situate within an area of five miles from the coast of the Colony, except with the consent of the Governor.
