

No. 286. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 5) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 5) 1941, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Registration of Retailers of Motor Spirit) Order, 1941, and shall be read in conjunction with the Defence (Motor Spirit) (Control of Sales) Order, 1941.

2. For the purposes of this Order—

“motor spirit” means any inflammable liquid substance capable of being used for driving motor vehicle and includes petrol, whether intended by the owner or purchaser to be used for such purposes or not.

“registered importer” means a person registered as an importer of motor spirit under the Defence (Motor Spirit) (Importation) Order, 1939.

“registered retailer” means a person licensed as a retailer of motor spirit under this Order.

3. On and from the 1st day of December, 1941, no person other than a registered importer or a registered retailer shall sell or otherwise dispose of any motor spirit.

4. Any person desiring to be registered under this Order as a retailer of motor spirit shall complete and deliver to me, at Nicosia, an application for a licence in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto.

5. A licence under this Order may be granted or refused at my discretion and may contain such terms, limitations and conditions as I may think fit to impose.

6. Every registered retailer shall within 4 days of the last day of each month or at such other time as I may require of him in writing, complete and deliver to me, in Nicosia, a return in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto. He shall at the same time surrender to me purchase coupons corresponding to the quantities of motor spirit disposed of by him during the previous month.

7. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes under any of the provisions of this Order, a declaration or return which is false in any material particular,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 5) 1941.
