

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the most western corner of plot No. 974 shown on the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/13, locality "Exokinoti", on the road from the village of Orounda to the village of Akacha, and proceeds north-eastwards along the said road to the most northern point of plot No. 931 of the said plan on the boundary of the village of Orounda, locality "Kattokremmos"; thence north-eastwards and southwards along the said village boundary to the south-western corner of plot No. 355 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/21, locality "Laxia"; thence south-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 24, 23, 32, 28, 29, 30, 36, 35, 56 and 57 of the said plan, locality "Kamboudhia", plots Nos. 873, 863, 874, 878, 882, 896, 904, 903, 931, 930 and 932 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/20, locality "Spylios-tou-Vassili", plots Nos. 433, 435, 439, 440, 441, 442, 484, 545, 541, 539, 530, 528, 527, 515, 510, 499/1, 402, 401, 400, 394 and 393 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/28, locality "Kassandra", plots Nos. 915, 918, 913, 912, 911, 910, 889, 888, 854, 853, 851, 850, 847, 846, 835, 834, 833, 832, 825, 824, 823, 821, 820, 816, 810 and 809 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/20, plot No. 1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/21, locality "Exokinoti", and plot No. 805 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/20 to the most northern point of plot No. 805; thence northwards along the top of the slope in plot No. 950 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/12 to the south-western corner of plot No. 980 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX/13; thence north-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots No. 980 and 974 of the said plan to the point of commencement; all which said area is 971 donums or thereabouts as shown edged in red on the plan filed in the D.L.R.S. M.P. No. 644/31.

No 319. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 6) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 6) 1941, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Tailors Requisites Control) Order, 1941.

2. On or before the 31st December, 1941, every person who has in his possession or under his control any of the goods described in the first column of the First Schedule hereto in excess of the quantity described in the second column of the First Schedule hereto shall complete and deliver to me a return in duplicate in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto of the goods in his possession or under his control.

3. Not later than six days after the last day of each month commencing from the month of January, 1942, any person who has in his possession or under his control any of the goods described in the first column of the First Schedule hereto in excess of the quantity described in the second column of the First Schedule hereto shall complete and deliver to me a return, in duplicate, in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto of the goods in his possession or under his control.

4.—(a) On or after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control any of the goods described in the first column of the First Schedule hereto in excess of the quantity described in the second column of the First Schedule hereto shall sell or dispose of to any person any goods except under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which such goods are to be sold or purchased) as may be specified therein.

(c) Every person who has in his possession or under his control any of the goods described in the first column of the First Schedule hereto in excess of the quantity described in the second column of the First Schedule hereto shall keep in his premises a register showing the quantity and price of each kind of goods, the date and the person to whom the goods were sold, and issue a receipt from a counterfoiled book to the purchaser whether such a receipt is demanded or not by him.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes under any of the provisions of this Order, a declaration or return which is false in any material particular,

shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 6) 1941.
