### No. 323. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 6) 1941.

#### DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 45.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 45 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 6) 1941, do hereby depute the person for the time being holding the office designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which the Governor is empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraph (1) of regulation 45 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 6) 1941.

### No. 324. THE RURAL CONSTABLES LAWS, 1932 TO 1937.

#### NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Rural Constables Laws, 1932 to 1937, His Excellency the Governor, upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Kyrenia, has been pleased to direct and it is hereby directed as follows:—

- The three adjacent villages of Myrtou, Panagra and Kremama Kamilou, in the District of Kyrenia, shall be united into a group for the purposes of the said Laws;
- The Mukhtar of the village of Myrtou as aforementioned shall be the Mukhtar of the Group Commission for all purposes of the said Laws;
- The directions contained in the Notification under No. 143 of the *Gazette* of the 17th February, 1933, in so far as they relate to Panagra and Kremama Kamilou, are hereby revoked.
