THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1941, (Suspension of Certain Provisions) Regulations, 1941, and shall be construed as one with the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

(2) The Interpretation Law, 1935, shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law.

2. During the continuance in force of these regulations sub-section (3) of section 14 and sections 15, 16, 17 and 19 of the principal Law shall be suspended and the following sub-section and sections shall have effect in lieu thereof:—

Suspension of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 14 and sections 15, 16, 17 and 19 of the principal Law.
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" 14.—(3) The electors roll shall be completed before the twelfth day of May, 1941, and shall come into operation on that day and shall remain in operation one year therefrom.

Rectification of electors rolls.

15.—(1) Any person whose claim to have his name inserted in the electors list has been rejected or whose name has been expunged therefrom may apply, not later than the fifteenth day of May, 1941, to a Judge of the District Court of the district in which the municipal corporation is situated for an order directing the Mayor to insert the name of such person in the electors roll, and the Judge shall thereupon, and in any event not later than the fourth day of June, 1941, enquire whether such person is entitled to be enrolled in accordance with the provisions of this Law and if satisfied that such person is so entitled shall order accordingly.

(2) Any person whose name appears in the electors roll and whose objection to the inclusion of the name of any person or persons in the electors list has been dismissed by the Mayor may apply not later than the fifteenth day of May, 1941, to a Judge of the District Court of the district in which the municipal corporation is situated for an order directing the Mayor to strike the name of such person or persons off the electors roll, and the Judge shall thereupon, and in any event not later than the fourth day of June, 1941, enquire whether such person or persons are entitled to be enrolled in accordance with the provisions of this Law, and if satisfied that such person or persons are not so entitled shall order accordingly.

(3) The decision of a Judge of a District Court upon any application under this section shall be final and conclusive.

(4) If a Judge of a District Court orders that the name of any person shall be inserted in the electors roll the Mayor shall insert it in such roll, and shall add thereto the words 'By order of the Court' and his signature.

(5) If a Judge of a District Court orders that the name of any person shall be struck off the electors roll, the Mayor shall strike off such name and shall add thereto the words 'By order of the Court' and his signature.

Electors rolls to be kept by Town Clerk.

16. The electors roll of every municipal corporation shall be kept by the Town Clerk thereof, and shall be open to the inspection of every elector thereof, and the Town Clerk shall permit any elector to make a copy of the whole or any part of such roll.

Copy of electors roll to be given to Returning Officer.

17. The Town Clerk shall, on or before the fourteenth day of June, 1941, cause a copy of the electors roll, signed by the Mayor, to be given to the Returning Officer.

Notice of election.

19. On or before the fifth day of June, 1941, the Returning Officer shall prepare, sign and publish a notice of election in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this Law.

Suspension of First Schedule to the principal Law.

3. During the continuance in force of these regulations the First Schedule to the principal Law shall be suspended and the following Schedule shall have effect in lieu thereof:—

“FIRST SCHEDULE.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION AND REVISION OF ELECTORS LISTS.

1.—(1) Every person who claims to have his name inserted in the electors list shall on or before the eighth day of March, 1941, give notice in writing of his claim to the Town Clerk in the form set forth as Form One in this Schedule. The particulars contained in such notice of claim shall be verified by one householder.

(2) Any person who knowingly makes any false statement in any notice of claim, whether the claimant or the person verifying such claim, shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

2. On or before the thirty-first day of March, 1941, the Town Clerk shall make and sign a list in the form set forth as Form Two in this Schedule, called the electors list, of all Christians entitled to be enrolled in the electors roll for the year, and a list in the same form of all Moslems entitled to be enrolled in the electors roll for the year.

3. The Town Clerk shall keep open to public inspection on the first ten days of April, 1941, a copy of each electors list made by him.

4. Every person whose name is not in the electors list and who claims to have it inserted therein shall on or before the tenth day of April, 1941, give notice in writing of his claim to the Town Clerk in the form set forth as Form One in this Schedule.

5. Every person whose name is in the electors list may object in writing to any other person as not being entitled to have his name retained in the electors list.

6. Every person so objecting shall on or before the tenth day of April, 1941, give to the Town Clerk, and also serve in the manner provided by the Law on the person objected to, notice in writing of the objection in the form set forth as Form Three in this Schedule.

7. The Town Clerk shall make two separate lists in the form set forth as Forms Four and Five respectively in this Schedule of the claimants and the persons objected to (in this Schedule referred to as 'respondents') and shall cause copies thereof to be kept open for inspection by the public at the Town Clerk's office during office hours during the period twenty-fifth April to eighth May, 1941.

8. The Mayor shall revise the electors lists.

9. The Mayor shall for this purpose hold an open court in the municipal office from the twenty-fifth day of April to the eighth day of May, 1941.

10. The Town Clerk shall publish three days' notice of the holding of the election court.

11. The Town Clerk shall at the opening of the election court produce the electors lists and a copy of the lists of claimants and respondents.

12. The Mayor shall insert in the electors lists the name of every person who has duly claimed to have his name inserted therein and is proved to the satisfaction of the Mayor to be so entitled.

13. Subject as aforesaid the Mayor shall retain in the electors lists the name of every person to whom objection has not been duly made.

14. The Mayor shall also retain therein the name of every respondent unless the objector appears in person, or by a person authorized by him, in support of the objection.

15. Where the objector so appears, the Mayor shall require proof of the respondent's qualification, and, if it is not proved to the satisfaction of the Mayor, he shall expunge the respondent's name from the electors list.

16. The Mayor shall correct any mistake and supply any omission proved to have been made in any of the lists with respect to any person or his abode.

17. The Town Clerk shall attend the hearing of all such claims and objections.

18. The Mayor may examine on oath the Town Clerk and any claimant, objector, respondent or witness.

19. The Mayor shall determine the validity of all claims and objections.

20. The Mayor shall write his initials against each name inserted or expunged and against any part of the list in which a mistake has been corrected or omission supplied, and shall sign his name on every page of the list so revised.

21. The Mayor in his discretion may award costs to any party in any claim or objection and such costs may be recovered as a civil debt.

22.—(1) The Town Clerk shall upon application supply every person whose name appears on the electors roll with a voters card in the form set forth as Form Six in this Schedule.

(2) Any person who forges a voters card shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
