No. 42. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATIONS 61 AND 83 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.**
