THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) (Amendment) Order, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) Order, 1940, (hereinafter called "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together by cited as the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) Orders, 1940 to 1941.

2. Clause 5 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause substituted therefor:-

"5.—(1) Any person who wants to buy or otherwise acquire any tyres shall apply to the Commissioner of the District in which he resides or carries on business for a certificate that he is a person who is in fact in need of such tyres as may be specified in the certificate, and the Commissioner may there upon grant or refuse such a certificate:

Provided that any permit issued by a Commissioner before the 6th March, 1941, shall be treated as and shall be deemed to be, a certificate granted under the provisions of this clause.

(2) Upon the production to me of a certificate issued by a Commissioner under the provisions of sub-clause (1) hereof I may grant to the holder of such certificate a permit to buy or otherwise acquire such tyres as may be specified in the permit."

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion after clause 5 of the following clause :—

"5A. From and after the 6th March, 1941,

- (a) no person shall buy or otherwise acquire any tyres unless he is in possession of a permit issued by me under the provisions of clause 5 (2);
- (b) no person shall sell or otherwise dispose of any tyres except to a person who is in possession of a permit issued by me under the provisions of clause 5 (2)."
