No. 50. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2010

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1941.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the second and third columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, printed papers, commercial papers, samples, small packets and postcards intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected—

- (a) by surface route from the Colony to Egypt or Palestine; and
- (b) from Egypt or Palestine to the country of destination either wholly by air or partially by air and partially by surface route.

3. The Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1941, is hereby revoked.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO (No. 2) 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 4 (2).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 (2) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to (No. 2) 1940, and with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) Order, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (No. 2) Orders, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (No. 2) Orders, 1940 to 1941.
