THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. The operation of regulations 7, 8 and 9 of the Exportation of Animals Regulations, 1930, shall, during the continuance in force of this regulation, be suspended in so far as they may affect any animals intended for export for use by His Majesty's Forces or the Forces of any State at war with any State at war with His Majesty.

2. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st November, 1940.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Law, 1939, (Suspension of Certain Provisions) Regulations, 1941, and shall be construed as one with the Forest Law, 1939, (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Law").

(2) The Interpretation Law, 1935, shall apply to these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law.

2. During the continuance in force of these regulations sub-section (1) of section 9 of the principal Law shall be suspended and the following sub-section shall have effect in lieu thereof:—

"(1) Any person or body of persons who claim that any immovable property belonging to him or them has been included in any forest or area declared to be a Main State Forest or a Minor State Forest by an Order of the Governor in Council under section 3 may, within five months from the date of the publication of such Order in the *Gazette*, lodge a petition in writing in the prescribed form (hereinafter in this section called "the petition") with the President of the District Court of the District within which the immovable property in respect of which the petition is made is situate specifying the grounds upon which the petitioner relies to establish his claim."

3. These regulations shall remain in force until the 1st day of June, 1941.
