

No. 87. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, to (No. 1) 1941, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks and Control of Sales of Cement) Order, 1941.

2. Every person (whether such person is an importer, merchant, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of cement in excess of $\frac{1}{2}$ ton shall complete and deliver to the Director of Public Works not later than the 24th April, 1941, a return in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of cement in his possession or under his control.

3.—(a) On and from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of cement in excess of the quantity mentioned in clause 2 of this Order, shall make use of, or shall sell, or otherwise dispose of any cement to any person, except under a special permit issued by the Director of Public Works.

(b) Every permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been, or are being, complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order :

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes a return under clause 2 of this Order which is false in any material particular,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1941.

6. The Defence (Returns of Stocks and Sales of Cement) Order, 1941, is hereby revoked. Provided that any person who has made a return under the provisions of the Order hereby repealed shall be deemed to have made a return under the provisions of this Order and any return so made shall be deemed to be a return made for the purposes of this Order.

7. The Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Orders, 1939 and 1940, in so far as they relate to cement, are hereby revoked.
