THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAW, 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2011

MADE UNDER SECTION 25 (a) (i).

Authority to the Summer Resort Development Board of Kalopanayiotis to contract a loan.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 (a) (i) of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, do hereby order as follows:—

That the Summer Resort Development Board of Kalopanayiotis (hereinafter referred to as "the Board"), shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty seven pounds and ten shillings (£157.10.0) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say,—

(a) that the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Loan Commissioners in five equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);

(b) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the purpose of developing the Kellia water supply.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

The operation of the Antiquities (Admission Fees to Museums and Ancient Monuments) Regulations, 1940, shall, in so far as they relate to item 10 (Kyrenia Castle) in the Schedule thereto, be suspended during the continuance in force of these regulations.
