THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO (No. 2) 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

W. D. BATTERSHILL, Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to (No. 2) 1940, do hereby order that the following territory shall be treated as enemy territory for the purpose of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to (No. 2) 1940:—

All Greek territory (with the exception of Crete).

No. 100. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.

Delegation of Power under Paragraph (5) of Regulation 66.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1941, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to depute the person for the time being holding the office designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform on the Governor's behalf the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which the Governor is empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1941.

## SCHEDULE.

The power to requisition imported flour and the power connected with such requisitioning conferred by paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1941.
