

Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article VA of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935, as amended by the Defence (Amendment of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935) Regulations, 1942, do hereby proclaim and declare that the currency notes specified in the Schedule hereto shall be current and legal tender in Cyprus for the payment of any amount and generally for all the purposes of the Cyprus Coinage Order, 1900.

SCHEDULE.

The Currency Notes of the denominations of one Palestine pound and five Palestine pounds issued by the Palestine Currency Board.

No. 144. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

DELEGATION OF POWER UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, do hereby depute the Controller of Transport to exercise and perform on my behalf the powers mentioned in the Schedule hereto, which I am empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942.

2. Nothing in this Order contained shall affect the operation and validity of the Order published under Notification No. 159 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 30th June, 1941.

SCHEDULE.

The power to requisition any mechanically propelled vehicle and any tyres or spare parts of such vehicles, and the powers connected with such requisitioning conferred by paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942.

No. 145. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Licensing of Dealers of Certain Goods) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Licensing of Dealers of Certain Goods) Orders, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Licensing of Dealers of Certain Goods) Orders, 1942 to (No. 2) 1942.

2. Paragraph (a) of clause 7 of the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:—

"(a) all goods in respect of which any person has been convicted or in respect of which the licence was issued shall vest in the Commissioner of the District;"
