SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 15. BY THE GOVERNOR.
A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Philani, in the District of Nicosia, should be abolished.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 3) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the village of Philani in the District of Nicosia shall, for all administrative purposes be abolished as from the 1st day of March, 1942, and that the whole of the present area of the said village shall be transferred to Politiko village in the District of Nicosia and shall form one common area of the said village of Politiko as from the said date.

Given under my hand and Public Seal of the Colony at Nicosia, this 23rd day of January, 1942.

No. 16. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1941. *Or. by 43/445.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2036

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1941, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods Prohibition (Amendment) Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Export of Goods Prohibition Orders, 1941 to (No. 2) 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Export of Goods Prohibition Orders, 1941 to 1942.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following item:—

" 2. Carobs, including the meal, seed and gum of carobs."
