No. 152. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Raisin and Carob Bread) Amendment Order, 1942 and shall be read as one with the Defence (Raisin and Carob Bread) Order, 1942 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Raisin and Carob Bread) Orders, 1942.

2. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"3. From and after the 8th of May, 1942, no person shall bake for his own use or for sale, or shall sell, offer for sale, or expose for sale, any bread, except bread containing either—

- (a) a quantity of raisins not less than five per cent. of the whole weight of bread, or
- (b) a quantity of carob meal not less than five per cent. of the whole weight of bread."

ORDER MADE BY THE BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT OF PAPHOS.

Notice No. 2 under Clause 4.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Parts 23, 30, 36, 37, 67 and the substitution therefor of the following:—

- "23. Eggs :
 - In town 15 piastres per dozen
 - In villages 12 piastres per dozen
- 30. Artichokes :
 - Sales to retailers 3½ piastres per oke
 - Sales to consumers 4½ " "
- 36. Broad beans, fresh :
 - Sales to retailers 3½ " "
 - Sales to consumers 4 " "
- 37. Green peas :
 - Sales to retailers 6 " "
 - Sales to consumers 6½ " "
- 67. Chairs, local, town :
 - (a) Oak, plane, mulberry tree up to 5 ^{ft.} ~~(feet)~~ width with 'kazavi' seat, uncoloured and unvarnished 4s. each
 - (b) Oak, plane, mulberry tree up to 5 ^{ft.} ~~(feet)~~ width with 'kazavi' seat, coloured and varnished 5s. 4½p. each
 - (c) All other wood, with 'floudhi' seat 3s. each."

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:—
