No. 176. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942. c/

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITIES UNDER REGULATION 3.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 3 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

The Notification No. 57, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th February, 1942, relating to the appointment of the Central and District Boards as Competent Authorities for the purpose of fixing the maximum prices at which any goods or articles produced or grown in Cyprus or made or consisting of materials mainly produced or grown in Cyprus may be sold, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraph:—

“3. The Central Board may—

- (a) call upon the District Boards to fix the maximum prices at which any goods or articles to which this instrument applies may be sold;
- (b) modify, alter or amend any prices fixed by the District Boards.”

No. 177. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 55.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 55 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, do hereby make the following order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Motor Transport) Order, 1942.

2. Notwithstanding anything in any Law or public instrument contained, from and after the first day of July, 1942, no motor vehicle shall be used on any road within the Colony, except under a permit granted under the hand of the Controller of Transport, or of any person authorized by him in writing in that behalf, and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such permit.

3. Every person in charge of a motor vehicle shall render such motor vehicle, when not being driven, incapable of use by the removal of such part of the mechanism as may, from time to time, be directed by the Controller of Transport.

4. Nothing in this order contained shall apply to any motor vehicles belonging to, or hired by, His Majesty's Forces.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of this order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942.

6. The Defence (Control of Use of Motor Vehicles) Order, 1941, is hereby revoked.
