No. 191. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

Order made by the Competent Authority under Regulation 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, I hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Stocks of Local Soap) Amendment Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Stocks of Local Soap) Order, 1942, (hereinafter called the "principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Stocks of Local Soap) Orders, 1942.

2. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"4. Not later than six days after the last day of each month, commencing from the month of May, 1942, all persons who deal in local soap and all persons who have in their possession or under their control any local soap in excess of one case containing approximately 30 okes of local soap shall complete and deliver to me a return containing the particulars set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of their dealings in local soap."
