

No. 218. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 5) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT OF LIMASSOL.

Notice No. 8 under Clause 4.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 13 of (b) and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“ Mutton, one year old and upwards : ~~30~~ ⁴⁰ piastres per oke.” *£ 215*
 (b) Other cuts

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 14 of (b) and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“ Lamb, under one year old
 (b) Other cuts *£ 215* ⁴⁰ piastres per oke.”

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 15 of (b) and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“ He-goats, over one year old :
 (b) Other cuts 27 piastres per oke.”

D.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 16 of (b) and the substitution therefor of the following :

“ She-goats, over one year old :
 (b) Other cuts 24 piastres per oke.”

E.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 17 of (b) and the substitution therefor of the following :

“ Kid, he or she-goats less than one year old :
 (b) Other cuts 33 piastres per oke.”

F.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition to Parts 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of the following :—

“ *Modification* : Where meat is sold in Pano Platres the maximum price shall be that fixed for Limassol town and where meat is sold at Troodos and Pano Amiandos the maximum price shall be 2 piastres per oke less than the maximum price fixed for Limassol town, and where meat is sold in any other village in Limassol District the maximum price shall be 4 piastres per oke less than the maximum price fixed for Limassol town.”

G.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 20 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

H.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following :—

“ 22. Poultry :
 (a) Fowls (live weight) 30p. per oke 26p. per oke.
 (b) Turkeys (live weight) 34p. „ 30p. „

Modification : Where fowls and turkeys are sold in Pano Platres, Pano Amiandos, Troodos and Prodhromos the maximum price shall be that fixed for Limassol town.”

NOTES.—(1) The prices in F and G above are as amended by the Central Price Fixing Board.

(2) The prices from A to F above will come into force on and from the 16th June, 1942.
