A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following :—

## " 78.—TOMATOES:

" Modification: Where meat is sold in villages in the Paphos District the maximum price shall be 4 piastres per oke less than the maximum prices fixed for Paphos town (Ktima)."
