The Second Schedule to the Notification No. 57, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th February, 1942, relating to the appointment of Central and District Boards as Competent Authorities for the purpose of fixing the maximum prices at which any goods or articles produced or grown in Cyprus or made or consisting of materials mainly produced or grown in Cyprus may be sold, is hereby further amended by the addition thereto of the following name:—

No. 287. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 7) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Prohibition of Gambling for Stakes Consisting of Articles of Foodstuffs and Tobacco) Order, 1942.

2. In this Order the expression “foodstuffs” includes every article used for food or drink by man, other than drugs or water, and any article which ordinarily enters into or is used in the composition or preparation of human food or flavouring matters or condiments.

3. Notwithstanding anything in any Law or public instrument contained no person shall gamble for stakes consisting of articles of foodstuffs and tobacco.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order are being complied with.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942.
