ORDER MADE BY THE BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT OF NICOSIA.

*Notice No. 10 under Clause 4.*

The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following parts :—

20.	Carcass of pork	..	..	33	piastres per oke.
21.	„ of mutton	..	..	24	„ „
22.	„ of lamb	..	..	34	„ „
23.	„ of he-goat	..	..	24	„ „
24.	„ of she-goat	..	..	20	„ „
25.	„ of kid	..	..	32	„ „

In parts 20 to 25—

- (a) 'carcass' means the whole of the dressed carcass including the head, liver, lungs and heart; and in the case of pork shall include the skin.
- (b) 'lamb' means sheep not exceeding one year of age, *i.e.* having no permanent teeth.
- (c) the prices include all charges incurred up to the time of the removal of the carcass from the slaughter-house."

ORDER MADE BY THE BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT OF LIMASSOL.

*Notice No. 11 under Clause 4.*

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion of the Modification to Parts 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

"*Modification* : Where meat is sold in Pano Platres and Troodos the maximum price shall be that fixed for Limassol town and where meat is sold at Pano Amiandos the maximum price shall be 2 piastres per oke less than the maximum price fixed for Limassol town, and where meat is sold in any other village in Limassol District the maximum price shall be 4 piastres per oke less than the maximum price fixed for Limassol town."

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 22 (relating to poultry).
