ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Bakery and Bread) Amendment

Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Bakery and Bread) Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Bakery and Bread) Orders. 1942.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
(a) by the deletion therefrom of the definition "barley flour" and the substitution therefor of the following definition:-

"barley flour" means the ground products of the whole barley with not more than 18% and not less than 15% of the bran having been extracted therefrom, and free from other cereals, any foreign matter and added bran;";

(b) by the deletion therefrom of the definition "whole wheat flour" and the "whole wheat flour" means the ground products of the whole wheat

with not more than 10% and not less than 8% of the bran having been extracted therefrom, and free from other cereals, any foreign matter and added bran, and without any white flour or flour known as 'semolina' having been extracted therefrom.".
