RULES OF SALE, 1942.

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and assistance of the Chief Justice and of the Director of Land Registration and Surveys, and in exercise of the power and authority vested in him by Section 98 of the Civil Procedure Laws, 1885 to 1939, is pleased to make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Rules of Sale, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Rules of Sale, 1923, and the Rules of Sale, 1934 (both of which are hereinafter referred to collectively as "the principal Rules"), and these rules and the principal Rules may together be cited as the Rules of Sale, 1923 to 1942.

2. Rule 1 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion of—
(a) the word "of" and the commas in line 2; and

(b) the second sentence, beginning with the word "If" to the end of the rule.

3. Rule 4 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "auctioneer" in line 2, and the substitution therefor of the words "appropriate Mukhtar".

~~4. Rule 14 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the addition to part (1) of the following:—~~

~~"For the posting of a notice of sale in any place other than the Court House 1e."~~

5. These rules shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 74 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 74 (1) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to direct and it is hereby directed that the tax mentioned in section 65 of the said Laws payable by the Maronite tax payers of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be increased by the rate per thousand mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule hereto to provide the amount required for the payment of loans or annual maintenance of the Maronite schools of the said villages respectively.
