THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 7) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Olives Control) Order, 1942.

2. In this Order—

"olives" means locally grown olives whether preserved in brine

or not;
"oil" means olive oil;

- " press" means olive press;
 sale" or "sell" includes—
 - (a) any offer to sell;

(b) any attempt to sell; and

- (c) any arrangement to sell made either directly or indirectly.
- 3.—(1) No person shall keep or work a press of any kind except under a permit issued under the hand of the Commissioner of the District.
- (2) Every permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (1) of this clause may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.
- 4. On or before the 1st day of September, 1942, every person wishing to keep or work a press shall apply in writing to the Commissioner of the District for a permit under clause 3 of this Order stating—

(a) name and full address;

(b) the locality where the press is situated;

- (c) the total quantity of olives pressed in the press in 1940;
- (d) the total quantity of oil produced in the press in 1940.
- 5. No person shall sell or otherwise dispose of any oil or olives without the previous permission in writing of the Commissioner of the District. Such permission may be general or in respect of a particular transaction and may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.
- 6. Every person who has in his possession or under his control any olives in excess of 20 okes or any oil in excess of 25 okes shall, not later than six days after the 15th day of each month commencing from the month of October, 1942, complete and deliver to the Commissioner of the District a return in the form in the Schedule to this Order in respect of the olives or oil in his possession or under his control:

Provided that any person in possession of a permit to work or keep a press in accordance with clause 3 of this Order shall not be required to submit returns under this clause.

7. Any person that I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf may enter upon any premises and make such enquiries or inspection therein as may be necessary for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

8. Any person who—

- (a) contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order:
- (b) makes any return required to be made under this Order which is false in any material particular;
- (c) makes any false statement in any application for a permit under this Order:
- (d) fails to comply with any condition in any permit issued under this Order:
- (e) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of clause 7 of this Order;

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942.
