THE MINIMUM WAGE LAW, 1941.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2039

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

C. C. Woolley, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Minimum Wage Law, 1941, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wage (Nahieh of Khrysokhou) Order, 1942.
- 2. The minimum rate of wages to be paid in respect of the undermentioned occupations followed by persons in the occupation of mining in the Nahieh of Khrysokhou, in the District of Paphos, shall be as follows:—

## For an eight-hour day:
