A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part I (relating to Poultry).

In parts 39 to 44—

(a) ‘carcass’ means the whole of the dressed carcass including the head, liver, lungs and heart; and in the case of pork shall include the skin.

(b) ‘lamb’ means sheep not exceeding one year of age, *i.e.* having no permanent teeth.

(c) the prices include all charges incurred up to the time of the removal of the carcass from the slaughter-house.”
