No. 357. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 7) 1942.

Direction given by the Governor under Regulation $79a\,(1)$ and (2).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraphs (1) and (2) of regulation 79A of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, do hereby

1.—(1) Every officer holding an appointment in the permanent establishment of the Public Service of the Colony shall continue to perform the duties he is performing on the date of this Direction or any duties to which he may lawfully be transferred hereafter, and shall not cease to perform such duties without the consent in writing of the Governor.

(2) Every person appointed to an office in the permanent establishment of the Public Service of the Colony after the date of this Direction shall perform, and continue to perform, the duties of the office to which he is appointed or any duties to which he may lawfully be transferred thereafter, and shall not cease to perform such duties without the consent in writing of the Governor.

2. Officers performing duties as required by paragraph 1 of this Direction shall receive such remuneration as may, from time to time, be fixed by the Governor for the holder of the office concerned, and shall perform such duties under the conditions of service laid down by the Colonial Regulations and the Cyprus General Orders for the time being in force in the Colony

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITIES UNDER REGULATION 3.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 3 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—
