

No. 36. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) (Amendment) Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Order, 1941, (hereinafter called "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Orders, 1941 and 1942.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:—

3. The provisions of clauses 2, 3, and 4 of the principal Order shall apply to the articles described in clause 2 of this Order as they apply to the articles described in the First Schedule to the principal Order.

No. 37. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942; I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of certain Stocks) Order, 1942.

2. For the purposes of this Order—

"goods" means every kind of movable property but shall not include things in action, money and the goods specified in the First Schedule hereto;

"seller of goods" includes a seller of goods acting as an agent;

"supplier of goods" means a person carrying on business in the course of which he supplies goods for the purpose of, or in pursuance of, a contract made by him for work, labour and materials.

3. Within ten days from the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* every person who carries on any business as a seller or supplier of goods which goods are:—

(a) for the time being owned by him in the course of such business; and

(b) situated on land within the Colony; and

(c) of a value exceeding £1,000,

shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth, and containing the particulars, in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of any such goods in his possession or under his control.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the accuracy of any return made by such person under the provisions of this Order.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order; or

(b) makes, under the provisions of this Order, a return which is false in any material particular,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942.
