A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 22 and the substitution thereof of the following part :—

“PART 22.—FUEL OIL.

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 23 and the substitution thereof of the following part :—

Provided that kerosene, when sold by the oke in quantities not exceeding 4 okes, may be sold at a price not exceeding 7 piastres per oke, on the basis of 11 okes net per 4 gallons.

*Limitation*: No retailer shall be obliged to sell kerosene in a new sealed tin (with tin) in the following places: Nicosia, Famagusta, Larnaca, Limassol, Paphos, Kyrenia, Polis, Xeros, Lefkoniko, Peristerona (Nicosia District), Morphou and Lefkara.”

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 24 and the substitution thereof of the following part :—

“PART 24.—PETROL.

*Limitation*: No retailer shall be obliged to sell petrol in a new sealed tin (with tin) in the following places: Nicosia, Famagusta, Larnaca, Limassol, Paphos, Kyrenia, Polis, Xeros, Lefkoniko, Peristerona (Nicosia District), Morphou and Lefkara.”

D.—Part 38 of the Schedule is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of items 138, 139 and 140 and the substitution therefor of items 24A and 24B after item 24 and of item 102A after item 102 (as hereinafter) :—

"*Modification* : If any registered chemist or druggist purchases any quinine of the types mentioned in items 22 to 24B, both inclusive, and 112 to 115, both inclusive in column (1) of this part from any person entitled to sell such quinine at the prices set out in column (3) of this part, such chemist or druggist shall, with the permission in writing of the Director of Medical Services, when selling such quinine to the public, be entitled to add to the prices set out in column (3) of this part, by way of profit, a sum not exceeding 15 per centum.

For the purposes of this modification 'registered chemist and druggist' means a person registered as such under the provisions of the Pharmacy Laws, 1900 and 1926."

E.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 56 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

### THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 7) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 7) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Flax) Order, 1942.

2. In this Order—

"flax" means flax fibre and includes tow.
