No. 371. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1941.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION
OF NICOSIA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1941, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Nicosia Municipal (Amendment No. 2) Bye-laws, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Nicosia Municipal (Principal and Amended) Bye-laws, 1938 to 1942 (hereinafter called "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Nicosia Municipal (Principal and Amended) Bye-laws, 1938 to (No. 2) 1942.

2. Bye-law 9 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraphs immediately after paragraph (c) :—
