ORDER MADE BY THE BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT OF PAPHOS.

Notice No. 11 under Clause 4.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Parts 19 and 67 (relating to fresh butter locally made, and chairs, local, respectively).

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Parts 68 and 69 and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"68. Lime: Price ex kiln 20 paras per oke.
Price in town 30 paras per oke.
69. Gypsum: Price in town 20 paras per oke.
Price in villages 15 paras per oke."

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:—

"86. Chopped Straw:
Plain villages 1 piastre per oke.
Hill villages 1½ piastres per oke.
Town of Ktima and Kato Paphos .. 1¼ piastres per oke.

87. Onions:

In respect of sales to retailers .. 3 piastres per oke.
(Delivery in the town of Paphos).
In respect of sales to consumers .. 4 piastres per oke."
