THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939. ^{43/474.}

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2054

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Klirou to contract a loan.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Klirou (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the lenders"), the sum of one hundred and ten pounds (£110) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) The sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lenders in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).
- (b) The Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the amount borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate.
- (c) The sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the improvement of the drinking water supply of the village of Klirou.

THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2055

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Airgraph Rate of Postage) Order, 1942. *New section 2 by 43/474.*
- 2. The charge for an airgraph message from Cyprus to the United Kingdom written on a specially designed form obtainable at any Post Office shall be six pence for each completed form.
- 3. The Post Office (Airgraph Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, is hereby revoked.
