REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Cyprus Government Railway Law, 1906, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Railway (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Railway Regulations, 1939 to 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Railway Regulations, 1939 to (No. 2) 1942.
2. Part V of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations (under heading "Rates for Vehicles on Wheels, etc.") is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (2) (b) and the substitution thereof of the following:—
" (b) Bicycles accompanied by passengers will be charged at 3p. each, single journey only."

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Suspension Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1942.
2. The operation of clauses 2, 3 and 4 of the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 to 1941, shall, in so far as they relate to measles (item 14 in the First Schedule thereto), be suspended during the continuance in force of these regulations.

No. 422. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITIES UNDER REGULATION 3.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 3 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

The Second Schedule to Notification No. 57, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th February, 1942, relating to the appointment of Central and District Boards as Competent Authorities for the purpose of fixing the maximum prices at which any goods or articles produced or grown in Cyprus or made or consisting of materials mainly produced or grown in Cyprus may be sold, is hereby further amended by the addition thereto of the following name:—

"6. Mr. Nicolas Antoniou Pyrkas."
