

No. 423. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Materials) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Orders, 1941 to (No. 1) 1942 (hereinafter called "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Orders, 1941 to (No. 2) 1942.

No. 424. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Coal) Order, 1942.

2. Within three days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* every person who has in his possession or under his control any coal in excess of 50 okes shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the coal in his possession or under his control.

3. Not later than six days after the last day of each month, commencing from the month of November, 1942, any person who has in his possession or under his control any coal in excess of 50 okes shall complete and deliver to me a return containing the particulars set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of his dealings in coal.

4.—(a) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of coal in excess of 50 okes shall make use of or shall sell or dispose of any coal to any person except under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.
