THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES)
CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE No. 86 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 28 and the substitution thereof of the following Part:—

"PART 28.—SODA CRYSTALS (POTASSA).

In this part of the Schedule—

The term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of soda crystals in quantities of not less than one bag of approximately 70 okes."

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 48 and the substitution thereof of the following Part:—

"PART 48.—LOCALLY MANUFACTURED CIGARETTES.

In this Part of the Schedule—

- (a) the term 'wholesale' referred in column (3) means sale or purchase of cigarettes in quantities of not less than 50 drams of cigarettes at any one time or at any single transaction;
- (b) the term 'wholesale' referred in column (4) means sale or purchase of cigarettes in quantities of not less than 10 okes of cigarettes at any one time or at any single transaction."

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 18 and the substitution thereof of the following Part:—

"PART 18.—MATCHES.

Brand of Matches.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
All brands	1 shilling and 5½ piastres per packet of 10 boxes or 60 paras per one box.	15 shillings and 4 piastres per 100 boxes.

In this part of the Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of matches of not less than 100 boxes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Limitation: No person selling matches by retail shall refuse to sell a packet of 10 boxes."

D.—Part 38 of the Schedule is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the insertion therein immediately after the word "British" in item 2 of the words "or Palestinian";
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the words "British or" in item 8;
- (c) by the insertion therein immediately after the words "2cc." in item 10 of the words "of manufacture other than Palestinian";
- (d) by the deletion therefrom of item 135;
- (e) by the addition thereto of items 2A and 2B after item 2, of item 8A after item 8, of item 10A after item 10, of item 103A after item 103 and of item 138 after item 137, to be inserted in the appropriate columns of the said part :—

“*Limitation* : No person shall make use of, sell or otherwise dispose of any Tablets Dagenan (M & B 693) 0.5 gm. save—

(i) in pursuance of a prescription given by a medical practitioner; or

(ii) in pursuance of a permit issued under the hand of the Director of Medical Services.

For the purposes of this limitation ‘medical practitioner’ means any person registered as such under the provisions of the Medical Registration Laws, 1936 and 1939.”

No. 426. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

This Order may be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) Amendment Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Newsprint Control) Order, 1940 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Order”), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 and 1942.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the words “and any part of such paper” after the word “newspaper” in line 8.
