I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage)

Order, 1942.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, printed papers, commercial papers, samples, small packets and postcards intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected-(a) by air or surface route from the Colony to Egypt or Palestine; and

(b) from Egypt or Palestine to the country of destination either wholly by air or partially by air and partially by surface route.

3. The Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, is hereby revoked.

No. 440. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66. C. C. Woolley, Governor.

- I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, do hereby depute the Leather Control Board established under the provisions of the Defence (Control of Local Hides and Local Leather) Order, 1942, to exercise and perform on my behalf the power to requisition local hides and local leather and the powers connected with such requisitioning which I am empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942.
- 2. The powers hereby deputed to the Board shall be exercised through the Chairman of the Board.
