No. 44. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Quinine) Order, 1942.

A. 42/210.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires :—

“ Director ” means the Director of Medical Services.

“ Registered chemist and druggist ” means any person registered as chemist and druggist under the provisions of the Pharmacy Laws, 1900 and 1926.

“ Quinine ” means any quinine of the kind mentioned in the First Schedule to this Order.

“ Registered importer ” means any person who is a registered importer under the provisions of the Defence (Drugs) Order, 1940.

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3. Within 8 days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every registered chemist and druggist and every registered importer who, on the date of the publication of this Order, has in his possession or under his control stocks of any quinine shall complete and deliver to the Director a declaration in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of such quinine in his possession or under his control.

4. Within 8 days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every registered chemist and druggist who, during the year 1941 sold or otherwise disposed any quinine, shall complete and deliver to the Director a return in the form set forth in the Third Schedule hereto in respect of such quinine sold or otherwise disposed.

5. Not later than 6 days after the last day of each month commencing from the month of February, 1942, every registered chemist and druggist and every registered importer who has in his possession or under his control any quinine, shall complete and deliver to the Director a return containing the particulars set forth in the Fourth Schedule hereto in respect of his dealings in quinine.

6. Every person to whom clauses 3, 4 and 5 of this Order apply shall permit such person as I, or the Director, may authorize by writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purposes of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been, or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any declaration or return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

7. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes, under any of the provisions of this Order, a declaration or return which is false in any material particular,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942.
