## THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

## ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Cart axles) Order, 1942.

2. In this Order—

“cart” means any vehicle drawn by animals;

“cart axle” means any unused axle intended for fitting or ordinarily fitted on carts;

“used cart axle” means any used cart axle which having at any time been fitted on to any cart has been, or is, removed from such cart or is, at the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, on any cart which is not in a serviceable condition.

3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to axles which on the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* are fitted on any cart which is in a serviceable condition.

4. Within 7 days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person who has in his possession or under his control any cart axles or used cart axles shall complete and deliver to the Controller of Transport at Nicosia a return in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto in respect of the cart axles and used cart axles in his possession or under his control.

5.—(a) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, no person who has in his possession or under his control any cart axles or used cart axles shall make use of, or shall sell or dispose of any such cart axles or used cart axles to any person except under a special permit issued under the hand of the Controller of Transport.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.

6. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District or the Controller of Transport may authorize by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

7. Any person who—

(a) contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order;

(b) makes any return required to be made under this Order which is false in any material particular;

(c) makes any false statement in any application for a permit under this Order;

(d) fails to comply with any condition in any permit issued under this Order;

(e) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of clause 6 of this Order;

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942.

THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Macaroni Manufacturers Control) Order, 1942.

2. In this Order—

“Macaroni” means macaroni of all kinds (including fideh and kritharaki).

“Macaroni Manufacturers” means any person who owns or controls any power driven factory wherein macaroni is manufactured.

3.—(a) From and after the 15th December, 1942, no person shall carry on the business of a macaroni manufacturer save under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of para. (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the quality and description of macaroni to be produced and the price at which such macaroni may be sold or purchased) as may be specified therein.

4. Every person engaged in the manufacture of macaroni shall—

(a) keep in his premises such books and records as I may direct ;

(b) not later than seven days after the last day of each month, commencing from the month of December, 1942, complete and deliver to me a return in the form of, and containing the particulars set out in, the Schedule to this Order.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the district may authorize by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this order.
