THE CONTROL OF CATTLE AND MEAT ORDERS, 1942.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under clause 6 of the Control of Cattle and Meat Orders, 1942, I hereby prescribe that, except when specially authorized by me in writing, no Mukhtar shall, between any Wednesday and the following Sunday, issue permits for the slaughter of cattle in excess of such number as will provide 50 drams of carcass weight in respect of each resident inhabitant of the village area in which the slaughtering takes place:

Provided that-

- (a) during the period between the 16th December, 1942, and the 20th December, 1942, the above quantity may be increased to 100 drams in respect of each Moslem inhabitant of the village; and
- (b) during the period between the 23rd December, 1942, and the 27th December, 1942, the above quantity may be increased to 100 drams in respect of each Christian or non-Moslem inhabitant of the village.
