Whereas special circumstances have been shown to exist in connection with the premises known as the Empire Bar and Restaurant situate on the corner of the Larnaca Road and Evagoras Avenue at Nicosia which make it just to exclude such premises from the operation of the Increase of Rent (Restriction) Law, 1942;

Now, therefore, I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Increase of Rent (Restriction) Law, 1942, do hereby declare that the premises known as the Empire Bar and Restaurant shall not be affected by the provisions of the said Law.

No. 511. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2063

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, printed papers, commercial papers, samples, small packets and postcards intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected—

- (a) by air or surface route from the Colony to Egypt or Palestine; and
- (b) from Egypt or Palestine to the country of destination either wholly by air or partially by air and partially by surface route.

3. The Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, is hereby revoked.

The Quarantine Law, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and it is hereby declared that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 179, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 21st May, 1942, is hereby cancelled.
